<p><b>NEW:</b> The fund flow model of ACA is based on a <b>60/30/10 disbursement</b>. After a group meets its month expenses &amp; sets aside money for a prudent reserve, <b>60% of what is left over is usually sent to the local Intergroup, 30% is sent to the Region, and 10% is sent to WSO.</b></p> <p>A prudent reserve usually is the amount that equals one to two month's worth of meeting expenses. Meeting expenses would include rent, utilities, and other group expenses.</p> <p>* Please note that Seventh Tradition contributions mailed to GEBACA take approximately 3 weeks to process.</p>
